evelation tells of the preservation of God's people Israel. Chapter 7:1-8 names the tribes that would be in existence in the closing age of time. He would know His own. We may not know all Israel by tribal identification, but God does. In 7:9 -17 after He had named the twelve tribes of Israel, He said some were tribulation saints who were the martyrs under Papal Rome for twelve-hundred-and-sixty years. "After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, kindreds, people, tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, palms in their hands; And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. And the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four living creatures, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God. And they said, Blessing, glory, wisdom, thanksqiving, honour, power, might, be unto God for ever and for ever. And one of the elders answered and said, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? whence came they? And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."

Revelation 8 tells of European wars which took place with the Gothics, Vandals, Huns, et cetera. Chapter 9 shows the rise of Islam.

In chapter 10, The Mighty Angel is Christ Himself. Now we're moving into the Protestant Reformation with two great eye-opening events. 1) Jesus Christ and Him alone as the means of our salvation. No pope, councils, mass, intervention of saints, Mariology, transubstantiation, none of that, just Christ and Christ alone. Jesus Christ is revealed in the great Protestant Reformation as the only Savior.

2) The Little Book is The Bible that we now hold. It was once locked up by the ruling religious establishment, but the Morning Star of the Reformation John Wycliffe began to translate this Bible. He was ostracized, but his writings went over to Bohemia, and awakened a man by the name of John Hus. A hundred years later we see Martin Luther saying, "the just shall live by faith."

Two great revelations: 1) Jesus as the only means of salvation, and 2) the Word of God. In 1450 A.D. Johan Gutenberg developed his printing press. The first book that was printed was the Bible. One main result of the Protestant Reformation was the rise of Christian Israel in economics, literature, education, science, government, standard of living and various inventions. God had a plan for His people and it all happened in Western Europe, the British Isles and then moved over to America. Concerning this fact Preterism ignores it, Futurism won't admit it, but we know that by the Word of God and the Historicist interpretation it's made very plain, yet remains unpopular.

In chapter 12 the Woman is Israel. "And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars:" It's Israel of Genesis 37 in Joseph's dream of the sun, moon and twelve stars. This woman gives birth to a Man Child who is to rule all nations with a rod of iron which is none other than the Lord Jesus Christ. We see this rod of iron again in Revelation 19 in the hand of Jesus Christ.

ix months ago we celebrated July 4th, Independence Day. Each year on this day we take time to remember not only the day, but also the men and women that sacrificed to bring forth an independent Nation and rightly so for it is a day to be remembered.

A few months ago, we paused to remember September 11th, a day to be remembered for the cost of American lives, an event that will have a lasting effect upon our nation. Recently we remembered December 7th, 1941, the day America was attacked by Japan.

We could go on with days that have been set aside to remember past events that have shaped our country and our lives. Yet when it comes to our religious freedom that we enjoy, we have decided in recent generations to cast that great day aside, not realizing the lasting effect upon the Protestant world and the world in general that one day impacted all mankind.

That day being October 31st, 1517 known as:

#### **REFORMATION DAY**

This is the day the Two Witnesses of Revelation chapter 11 were raised from the dead and stood as a wall of truth against all false dogma and doctrine of the apostate Church of Rome.

Before we look at the events surrounding this great day, take a moment and reflect upon the benefits you and I received as a result of this event.

- To attend the Church of your choice, or not to attend at all.
- To believe as per your own conscience.
- To read and have the Word of God, THE BIBLE.

#### We call this Freedom of Religion

A hundred years before 1517 a fire was being prepared at the feet of one John Huss, the Bohemian reformer. He was asked one last time to renounce his 'errors' as per Rome's charges against

His reply: "What errors, shall I renounce? I know myself guilty of none. I call God to witness that all that I have written

and preached has been with the view of rescuing souls from sin and perdition; and therefore most joyfully will I confirm with my blood that truth which I have written and preached."

The stakes were driven into the ground as he was held fast to the beam by a chain around his neck. The year was 1415. As his life was about to come to an end Huss proclaimed: "that you silence the goose, but a hundred years hence there will arise a swan whose singing you shall not be able to silence."

As the flames arose Huss began to sing "Jesus, thou son of David have mercy on me."
As the smoke of the flames choked him his singing ceased. Huss had given up the ghost. The fire would be rekindled three times to burn the body to complete ashes. The ashes were carefully collected along with the soil, carted away and thrown into the River Rhine.

The Rhine received his ashes. His tormentors proclaimed "Huss is dead." Yet, Huss is not dead. Life is found within the fire of his death. Bohemia is awakened. In a hundred years Germany and all Christendom will shake off their chains. It's time for the martyr's prophetic spirit foretold, "In the course of a hundred years you will answer to God and me." It was the night of October 30th, 1517 the Elector Frederick of Saxony had a dream which he relates to his brother Duke John on the morning of October 31st, 1517.

"Having gone to bed last night, I dreamed that Almighty God sent me a monk, who was a true son of the Apostle Paul. All the saints accompanied him by order of God, in order to bear testimony before me, and to declare that he did not come to contrive any plot, but that all that he did was according to the will of God. They asked me to have the goodness graciously to permit him to write something on

the door of the Church of the Castle of Wittenberg. This I granted through my chancellor. Thereupon the monk went to Church, and began to write in such large characters that I could not read the writing. The pen which he used was so large that its end reached as far as Rome, where it pierced the ears of a lion that was crouching there, and caused the Triple Crown upon the head of the Pope to shake. All the cardinals and princes, running hastily up, tried to prevent it from falling. You and I, brother, wished also to assist, and I stretched out my arm; but at that moment I awoke, with my arm in the air, quite amazed, and very much enraged at the monk for not managing his pen better.

"I was still half asleep, and once more closed my eyes. The dream returned. The lion, still annoyed by the pen, began to roar with all his might, so much so that the whole city of Rome, and all the states of the Holy Empire, ran to see what the matter was. The Pope requested them to oppose this monk, and applied particularly to me, on account of him being in my country. I again awoke. Falling asleep again I dreamed that all the princes of the Empire, and we among them, hastened to Rome, and strove, one after another to break the pen; but the more we tried the stiffer it became, sounding as if it had been made of iron. We at length desisted. I then asked the monk (for I was sometimes at Rome, and sometimes at Wittenberg) where he got this pen, and why it was so strong. The "Pen," replied he, belonged to an old goose of Bohemia a hundred years old. I got it from one of my old schoolmasters. As to its strength, it is owing to the impossibility of depriving it of its pith or marrow; and I am quite astonished at it myself. Suddenly I heard a loud noise; a large number of other pens had sprung out of the long pen of the monk. I awoke the third time; it was daylight."

A few hours later on October 31st, 1517 a monk by the name of Martin Luther nails his 95 Thesis on the doors of Wittenberg Castle, not knowing that within four weeks it will have been sent to countries far and wide until it was procured and read by none other than the Pope himself.

The words of Paul were proclaimed for the entire world to hear!!!

#### "The just shall live by faith"

Rome was revealed for what she was, the monk had arisen. The pen of the truth of God's Word that John Huss had died for has risen as iron and a new day for Christendom had come.

Now it was time for the other pens that had sprung out of the long pen of the monk to awaken Christendom to "Arise and Shine" of the glorious Gospel of the Protestant Reformation. Such men as:


#### **WORDS OF JESUS HIMSELF**

There are those who insist that He never claimed to be Very God. Let's see. "And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world." John 8:23. He said: "I and my Father are one." John 10:30. "...he that hath seen me hath seen the Father..." John 14:9. In the presence of His own people He said "...Before Abraham was, I am," John 8:58. His hearers understood that He claimed to be God — the "I Am" of the Old Testament. He not only claimed the attributes of God, but constantly stated the fact that He was God throughout His life and ministry by doing such things as only God can do.

There is no way of explaining the person of Jesus Christ only as we admit Him to be Very God as well as Very Man. Neither is there any way of explaining His teaching apart from the fact that He is God.

#### **JESUS' TEACHING ON SIN**



### THE LANGUAGE OF THE

## PROPHETS

"For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills." —Psalm 50:10

The Round Indefinite

do not know how many times over the last four decades that I have read the 50th Psalm. Many years ago, when I was pondering the consistent language of the prophets, their metaphors and allegories used from Adam to Malachi, did the implications of the above stated verse dawn on me! The Psalmist stated that God owns the cows on 1,000 hills. Ok then, but who owns the cow standing on hill 1,001? Are we being clued here in the Psalms, and other verses in scripture, to something very relevant to our time mentioned in the Revelation? I'll get back to this.

Let's examine one of the greatest revelations concerning the language of the prophets: The understanding of the DAY-FOR-A-YEAR truth when interpreting divine time measures, Ezekiel proclaimed, "I have appointed thee each day for a year." Ez. 4:6. One of the greatest demonstrations of this "language of the prophets" is found in Daniel chapter 9; the Messianic prophecy of the 70 Weeks (490 days for a year). All agree that these "weeks" are to be interpreted according to Ezekiel's revealed prophetic key. Have you ever asked yourself why then, in Daniel's sister book, The Revelation of Jesus Christ, are the divine time measures proclaimed as a "day for a day" by the Roman Catholic teachings on prophecy known as Futurism and Preterism? Many Protestants today are poisoned with this terrible curse of uncertainty!

In the Revelation, there are eight epochs of divine time measures. All have passed in history. Historicism properly interprets and defines this history. They are as follows: (I haven't forgot about cow 1,001)

1) The ten days' tribulation of the church at Smyrna Rev. 2:10. 2) The duration of the Scorpion torment Rev. 9:5. 3) The Career of the Euphratean horsemen Rev. 9:15. 4) The time of the down-treading of the Holy City Rev. 11:2. 5)

That of the prophesying of the two witnesses Rev. 11:3. 6) The time they lay unburied Rev. 11:9. 7) The Sojourn of the woman in the wilderness Rev. 12:6,14. 8) The period of the domination of the beast Rev. 13:6. (See these periods properly interpreted in *The Present Reign Of Jesus Christ.*)

Now back to cow 1,001. It is evident that the use of thousands here in the Psalm and other places in Scripture imply a round indefinite, not an exact calculation. Again, prophetic language is consistent in your Bible. And of course, God owns cow 1,001 and 1,002 and...etc.

Now with a measured understanding of the prophetic thousands let's look at, what for some is, the most puzzling use in Revelation chapter 20.

FOUR TIMES the word "thousands" is used! What meanest this? Is this another exact divine time measure? Is it an exactly calculated period yet to come? Does the day-for-a-year apply here? If it is, then is the prophecy revealing a divine time measure of 365,000 DAY YEARS yet to come? Absolutely not!! Furthermore, what is most frustrating for the author is the inability to address these questions in this short article. The good news is that I address the "thousands" in the "Present Reign" chapter 20 "THE SYMBOLIC MILLENIUM."

"God keeps covenant and mercy to a thousand generations" Deut. 7:9. Does His mercy stop there? Is generation 1,001 doomed? Did Moses cut God Short?

"Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever," proclaimed the prophet David in his psalm of thanksgiving in 1Chronicles 16:34.

It's a Contradiction, or the use of the round indefinite?

# DO YOU KNOW CHRIST BY PERSONAL REVELATION?

he most important question you could ever be asked is simply this: Do you in reality know the living Christ? The question is not, Are you religious? - Are you a church member? - Do you read the Bible? You may be very religious, yet not know Christ in your heart. You may be a loyal church member, a regular reader of God's Word, a person who "says" their prayers or one who loves to study religious books and doctrine. But, these soul-searching guestions still remain - Have you ever seen yourself as a lost, vile sinner before a holy God? Have you ever been stripped of your self-righteousness and laid low in the dust of humility? Have you ever viewed by faith the glorious person of the Lord Jesus Christ, all because of a direct and personal revelation to you by the Holy Spirit?

Sinner friend, I plead with you to not be deceived. Do not rest in your religious creeds, your attendance of religious worship or your so-called righteous acts. Rest only in Christ! Look only to Him! Be not content with any religion if Christ is not the center and substance of it! Do not be deceived by man-made religion! Seek that which comes by divine

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revelation, as Simon Peter had. Simon was blessed to know who Christ was by a personal revelation to him of God the Father! This must also be true of us. If Christ Jesus is not known to you by the revelation of the Holy Spirit, He is not

known as the very well-spring of blessedness to the soul. If you only know Jesus no more than the world knows or the learned among men know, you have not the real blessing. If you only know the Lord of glory by what you have found out



yourself, in reading or in talking to others, unaided by the Father's drawing power you are not blessed with true salvation. If you know no more of Christ than what flesh and blood has revealed to you, you are nothing more than a Pharisee or Sadducee – religious, but lost without God – a separatist or a rationalist, but not a recipient of revelation and regeneration. May the eternal God reveal to you your true and undone condition before Him!

Among the vast religious throngs of this earth there is to be found the true people of God. These chosen of the Father are also redeemed by the Son, and quickened by the Spirit. The elect of God know by deep acknowledgement of their sin that they are blind and ignorant by nature. The true children of God have been made humble, they confess their total dependence upon the grace and mercy of Christ, and place their entire confidence and faith in His meritorious righteousness and shed blood. In the Lord Jesus Christ alone do "we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace" (Ephesians 1:7).

Reader, what do you know of this once crucified, yet now living Christ? Does

His name bring gladness to your heart? Do you love the fragrance of His person? Is He more than just a religious leader to you? Beware of cloudy views of King Jesus! Beware lest you only have a head knowledge of Him! Make sure that Christ is your Surety, your Substitute, your Sacrifice and your Saviour. Beware of any religion which belittles Him or that does not exalt Him as the only way to God.

Do you believe in Jesus by an inward discernment of Him? Do you clearly see Him as the Son of man and the Son of God? Is He definitely your Lord and Saviour, your propitiation (satisfaction) before God? If you know Him thus you have not learned this by the instruction of men. You have had a direct and personal revelation made to you and in you by the Father concerning who Jesus Christ really is (Galatians 1:16).

## THE RELIGION OF HUMANISM

umanism is alive and well in America. Nationally and collectively most Americans observe a religion called "Humanism." This includes political parties, our monetary system, the media, the educational system, much of religion, and generally most of society.

The dictionary defines humanism as follows: "a doctrine, attitude or way of life centered on human interests or values; especially in philosophy that assets the dignity and worth of man and his capacity for self-realization through reason that often rejects supernaturalism." Doctrine, attitude, way of life centered on human interest and values? The last part of the above definition is that this doctrine, attitude and way of life often reject supernaturalism. In other words it rejects revelation and quidance from God. I call that the religion of humanism. The god worshipped in this religion is "man" himself. The humanist may even still profess to believe in God, worship Him and give Him a little lip service, but the humanist decides for himself what is good or bad, right or wrong, moral or immoral, what sin is and what is not.

While God's Law should govern every aspect of our lives, nationally, individually and even in government, we have many man-made laws and personal opinions that conflict with and violate God's Law. An honest simple reading of the Bible will reveal this.

thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way. Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." Psalm 119:104-105

Some time ago on the O'Reilly Factor they showed a segment where a Gallup poll was taken on morality in America, and was titled, "Sin, what is morally acceptable and unacceptable." It covered many issues, such as premarital sex, having a baby out of wedlock, abortion, pornography, adultery, death penalty and suicide. The results of the poll made it clear to me that society has trended toward more tolerant views as to what is acceptable than it held years ago. But what really got my attention was the lack of any mention of God, or the definition of sin, which is transgression of God's Law. (I John 3:4) It is all about what the people think, what the people thought was morally acceptable or immorally unacceptable.

In this poll not one person was asked "what does the Creator God say on the subject?" God's Word was/is not considered or mentioned. That's humanism.

How did we get to this point? By two main ways. First, by believing the false doctrine that all of the moral Laws of God were "nailed to the cross" and therefore done away with. But they weren't.

The second way was by our believing the lie of separation of Church and State. The Constitution nowhere teaches that idea, and certainly the Bible doesn't. The false doctrine of "Separation of Church and State" is merely a lie and a "smokescreen" elected officials hide behind so they don't have to obey God and His Laws as His Word commands them to do.

Man-made laws, apart from God's direction and laws, become arbitrary, inconsistent, unstable, unfair, corrupt and at the whim of politicians trying to please the people, or a segment of the people, rather than do what God demands of them. Man's laws can swing like a pendulum. One day they might be just, the next day unjust. What might be legal in one administration is illegal in the next.

God's Laws are holy, just, consistent and eternal. God is not a flip flopper like the religion of humanism. That is comforting to me.

# CALVARY & THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD By Charles A. Jennings

"And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him," — Luke 23:33

t is my intention that each reader understands that the Anglo-Israel message is firmly based upon the principle of the "shedding of blood" whereby is Israel's only legal means to transact business with God.

The correct identification of God's people Israel as being the Anglo-Saxon and related families is not for the purpose of self-glory, but for the understanding of the plan of God as expressed in the Biblical covenants that He Himself made with His people. In the covenants that God initiated with Israel, the principle of the "shedding of blood" was the vital means to bind each party to the terms of the covenant.

The three all-encompassing purposes of the shedding of blood in Scripture are:

**1. Atonement** – means to "cover." In order to "cover" the first-born of every Israelite family in Egypt, God commanded that they apply the shed blood of a lamb to the door posts and lintel of their home. God said; "And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt" Ex. 12:13.

The writer of Hebrews made it clear that; "almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission" Heb. 9:22. The only remedy for sin is the atoning and cleansing power of the shed blood of our Savior Jesus Christ.



- 2. Redemption means to "buy back" that which was originally possessed, but was then "lost." When God divorced His people Israel in 721 B.C. because of their idolatry and unfaithfulness to Him, they were put away in punishment and therefore became "lost." The literal people still existed, but estranged in their relationship to their husband, the Lord God and were in need of redemption. That act of redemption was when Jesus died on the cross and paid the price to reestablish that covenant relationship with His wife, the House of Israel. The Apostle Paul stated that "we have redemption through His blood" Eph. 1:7. Historically it has been the people of the Christian nations of Northwestern Europe that have accepted the blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ as the only means to be "bought back" into national and personal covenant relationship with God.
- **3. Ratification of a Covenant** The Abrahamic and Mosaic covenants were sealed and ratified with the shedding of animal blood. The word 'ratify' means to confirm or make binding. In Jeremiah 31:31 the Lord declared; "Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah."

The writer of Hebrews identified this New Covenant as the Christian covenant that Jesus made and ratified with the shedding of His own blood. (Heb. 8:6-13). On the night of His betrayal by Judas the Lord Jesus declared to His disciples; "For this is my blood of the New Testament (covenant), which is shed for many for the remission of sins" Matt. 26:28.

"And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself" —Colossians 1:20

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#### THE COUNTER REFORMATION

Two Jesuits played a vital role in this. One was the Spanish theologian Luis de Alcazar. He developed the theory that the prophecies of Christ and of the book of Revelation were all fulfilled by 70ad. According to this scenario, the Beast of Revelation 13 was the Roman Empire. Nero in particular, was the anti-Christian Emperor who persecuted and slaughtered Christians. Alcazar's book An Investigation of the Hidden Sense of the Apocalypse was published in 1614. This view became known as Preterism, and has become more accepted in recent years. It is especially popular among those who believe in a spiritual Kingdom of God, which they believe was inaugurated in 70ad. There was undoubtedly a partial, but by no means final fulfilment of Prophecy in 70ad. The one major problem with the Preterist view is most scholars agree it is unlikely that the book of Revelation was written until approximately 96ad, which tells us much was yet to be fulfilled.

Francisco Ribera was the Spanish Jesuit theologian whose theory was to have a major impact on the Church. In his Commentary on the Gospel of the Apocalypse published in 1590, Ribera developed what became known as Futurism, based on the 'postponement' or 'gap' theory. This reinterprets Daniel 9:24-27. The period of "70 weeks" (490 years, calculated on a day for a year scale), was a prophecy divided into three parts:-

The rebuilding of Jerusalem in "7 weeks" (49 years);

A further "62 weeks" (434 years) "unto Messiah the prince" — "69 weeks" (483 years). Jesus was anointed as Christ (Messiah) at His baptism;

During the 70th week, "shall Messiah be cut off [put to death]". Christ made the final sacrifice and oblation forever "in the midst of the week", i.e. after 3½ years ministry. Daniel also prophesied the destruction of Jerusalem by Prince Titus of Rome, which occurred in 70ad (verse 26).

However, instead of applying this wonderful prophecy to Christ, Ribera totally distorted it by inventing an indeterminate gap between the 69th and 70th week of Daniel's prophecy, postponing the 70th week to the end of the Church age, and applying it, not to Christ, as clearly stated, but to Antichrist and a future 7 year 'Great Tribulation.' This led to a distorted view of the coming of Christ, that the Church will be 'caught up'—not just to meet the Lord as stated—but to heaven—which is not stated, while Antichrist takes over the earth!



#### **BIBLICAL HISTORICISM**

These two views—Preterism that pushes prophecy back into the past, and Futurism, that pushes it into the future, ignore the fact that Bible Prophecy has been progressively fulfilled throughout history. This was clearly the way Daniel, Jesus Himself, and the Apostles interpreted Prophecy. We refer to this as the Historical or Historicist view, not because it relates solely to the past, but the time-lines of Prophecy apply to the past, present and future. History is being made every day, and in this sense, Prophecy has, and is, being fulfilled daily.

Whereas most Historicists agree regarding time-cycles etc., there are differences of emphasis. Literal Historicism emphasises the fulfilment of major events throughout secular history. Church Historicism emphasises events in relation to the Church, as taught by the Reformers. National Historicism recognises the above, in the light of God's Plan for His True Israel, and the coming of Christ to reign on the Throne of David, as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

Much of Bible Prophecy that Futurists (Dispensationalists) apply to the future, has either already been fulfilled, or is reaching its final stages. We should not be taken in by futuristic fantasies. Rather, we should make our calling and election sure, and trust the Lord. "Even so come Lord Jesus!"
